

SEC. 4.10 - TERMINAL OPERATOR DEFINED

A Terminal Operator shall be any person offering to perform for the general public the following services in connection with a common carrier by water in interstate or foreign commerce upon facilities of the District:

(a) The handling, storing and/or delivering such cargoes;

(b) Such additional accessorial services as may be required in connection with such cargoes.

(Enacted May 10, 1966 - Ordinance No. 227)

SEC. 4.11 - TERMINAL OPERATOR REGULATIONS

Any person performing terminal operator services upon the marine terminal facilities owned and operated by the District, as such services are herein defined, shall comply with the following requirements:

(a) Maintain a permanent office upon District marine terminal facilities;

(b) Be prepared at all times to provide sufficient personnel to perform such terminal operator services as may be required by the general public;

(c) Maintain adequate equipment to perform such terminal operator services for the general public;
